First Steps

Check with your Squadron Commander, Operations or ES Officer for assistance.

- Personnel must have a General ES Rating
- Obtain sign in and password for NHQ E Services www.capnhq.gov/eServices.
- Take online course ES 116
- Investigate which area of CAP ES positions you have an interest in.
- Check the CAP Regulation 60-3 for information on ES functions.
- Utilize the Specialty Qualification Training Record (SQTR) for recording your ES training in that function. (found at E services)
