The Safety Triangle 330-29-1

In the typical injury case, the injured person has committed an unsafe act or has been exposed to an unsafe condition many times before the injury occurs. One study showed that for every 330 unsafe acts or exposures to an unsafe condition there were 29 injuries and 1 fatality. The way to eliminate the injuries and fatalities is to eliminate the unsafe acts and unsafe conditions. The fact that there are so many exposures before there is a serious injury can lead to complacency - "I've done this hundreds of times and never got hurt!". Remember, if you have had many exposures to an unsafe act or unsafe condition and have not yet been hurt, the probability of your getting injured is increasing. Whether it's in the air, on the ground, at work, or at home, take time to evaluate everything that you do to identify unsafe acts and unsafe conditions and eliminate them immediately.
